



APA Life Time Achievement Award to Prabhakar Kusuma, FRPS

Prabhakar Kusuma, Hyderabad had been awarded "Fellow of The Royal Photographic Society of Great Britain" on 24th May 2018, for his documentary work on the theme "TheDestitute". This honour, shortly called as FRPS, is the highest and rare honour in photography given by The Royal Photographic Society and is recognized world wide a samark of achieving the highest standard sand excellence inphotography.

His photographic journey started when he joined Federation of Indian Photography in 1977. He had served as Faculty at many photography workshops right from 1987, the latest being "NationalMasterArtists' Workshop 2017", organized by State University of Performing & Visual Arts, Rohtak, India. The refinedaes the ticsmanifested in his works are born of his very long experiencein the art and science of photography. Despite numerous technical advances in photography, he firmly believes that, "Photography is more human, intuitive and less mechanical". He is an ative of the historical town Warangal in Telangana state and had been based at Hyderabad since 1995.

His pictures were featured in many books, magazines and news papers. He served as Jury formany National and International Photography Salons. Heservedas Working Committee Member for Andhra Pradesh State Academy of Photography in 1987-91 and for Federation of Indian Photography in 1993-96. His pictures are in the collection of Federation Internationale de L' Art Photographique, Belgium; UNICEF; COMPIX, London; Kakatiya University, Telangana, India; Ford Foundation Project; Silk Route, Florida, USA and University of Hamburg, Germany.

- Amitabha Sil was born in Calcutta in the year 1954. He was very kin in Photography since his childhood. Initially he started Photography with Zenith Camera in 1977. In 1980 he purchased Asahi Pentax K-1000 camera. And ultimately he switched over to Digital Camera (Nikon D-90) in 2010. Now He is using Nikon D-7000 Camera.
- He is a Graduate (Chemistry Hons.) from Calcutta University in 1973.
- He retired from Allahabad Bank in 2014 after giving a long 38 years of service.
- He has persuaded many Photographic clubs to organize an international salons. Most of them have successfully organized many International salons.
- Also he has guided many young and new photographers to receive photographic honours.
- He has been organizing Inter Club Contest on behalf of our National Body of Photography (FIP) since 1986 as a Divisional Secretary. So far he has successfully organized 32yearly Inter Club Contests since 1986 without a break. It is a record in FIP.
- He was elected as one of the Working Committee members in 1995 for the first time. Since then he won every elections (Biennial) and continued as one of the Working Committee Members upto 2012. In 2013 he has been elected as Hon. Treasurer of FIP. Previously there was no separate post of

- Hon. Treasurer. Before 2013 it was tagged with Hon. General Secretay (i.e, Hon. secretary General and Treasurer). So he is the First separate Hon. Treasurer of FIP and continued upto 2016 (2 terms) successfully. During his tenure a lump sum amount of money has been saved.
- In 2017 he has been elected as Vice President of our National Body of Photography, i.e. Federation of Indian Photography (FIP).
- In 1982 he was the key man to organize 1*. All India Bank Employees Photographic Exhibition to promote art photography among the bank employees of India.
- In 1984 he was the key man to organize 1st. All India Salon of Mountain Photography to promote art photography among the mountaineers and trekkers of India.
- He is one of the Founder members of Chhayapath Photographic Club in Kolkata, one of the active photographic club of India. Under his Secretary ship, Chhayapath, Calcutta organized 1*. Digital International salon in 2010.
- He used to give lectures on different topics of photography in different workshops, Seminars, photographic classes to promote art photography.
- He has been acting as one of the jury members of different salons since 1988. So far he acted as one of the jury members in 210 different International Salons and 188 different National Salons / Photographic Competition.
- He introduced Black& White Infra-Red art photography in 1980 for the first time in India.
- He organized an All India Photographic Conference in Salt Lake, Calcutta to promote Art Photography in 1990. Although it was an All India Conference but many delegates from Bangladesh were attended that successful Photographic Conference.
- His ten photographs alongwith his profile published in the "FOTOKINO" magazine of Denmark in December, 1984.
- SEPETR Club of Republic of Belarus (previously U.S.S.R) invited his works for exhibiting the same in R. Belarus in 1992.
- His photographs had been invited from Malayasia for exhibition of "WORLD'S TOP PHOTOGRAPHERS" works in 2006 and 2016.

- So far he has acquired 2332 International acceptances from 60 different countries & 505 National acceptances
- He has received 174 awards from International and National salons.
- He has started photography seriously in 1978 and his first acceptance in salon came in 1981.



Born on the 27 July, 1954, Bhajanehatti Srinivasa is an Internationally acclaimed art photographer from Bangalore. B. Srinivasa, took up photography as a profession in 1968. He was soon drawn towards its artistic & creative aspects and has been at it since 1976. Till date he has more than 700 acceptances at National level including 75 awards & 60 Certificates of Merit. He also has 200 acceptances at International level including 22 awards and 25 Honorable metions. He has won the Macau Governor's Trophy for scoring the highest points for best set in the 3rd Macau International Salon in 1984. He has won the FAPA GOLD Medal at the 19th Internation Salon of the Photography Society of China in 1981. He Has also received Tamra Patra, an honour given to Navrathna, one among the 9 eminent Photo Artists of India, from the Photography Society of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal in 1989.

It was inevitable that International Honors began to follow. The Royal Photographic Society of London conferred ARPS in 1979 & FRPS in 1984 for B/W Nature Prints. The Federation International of Art Photography of Belgium conferred AFIAP in 1981 for B/W Nature Prints, EFIAP in 1985 for B/W Pictorial Prints and Ultimately the MFIAP in 1989 for B/W Nature prints. He has been a member of the Jury in the FIAP Distinction Panel form 1990 to 2000. He is now the Fellow & Honorary Fellow of Image Colleague Society International Limited (California, USA). He has been a judge in many of the National & Inetrnational Salons

Besides achieving personal photographics succes, he has

rendered yeoman printing services in Colour & B/W to fellow Art photograhers from all over India & Abroad. Many photographers owe their success to his excellent printing quality. Till date atleast 75 photographers have received distinctions using his printing services. He even encourages fellow art photographers to join him in his work and shares his knowledge & skill in 'Dark Room Techniques'. He has encouraged many a photographer to take up printing as a form of art, besides guiding them in Nature & Pictorial Photography. His quality of printing has been appreciated by the RPS, FIAP besides many other International bodies.

B. K. Agrawal, FIIPC

(Fellow India International Photographic Council.)

Born on 15th Feb. 1955 at Bolangir, Orissa in a business family. From Childhood I had deep interest in games like badminton, table tennis, chess and Yoga. Was a district champion in Badminton and table tennis and also represented University for them.

My brother gifted a Kodak box camera to me at the tender age of twelve and my love for photography started with it. Was able to somehow pursue his passion in spite of resistance from family members. With five beautiful sisters and their friend to pose at will, he did not have to look outside home for models to practice. This put him in a path of specializing Portrait Photography.

Came to Visakhapatnam in 1981 to expend family business in Automobile tyres and tubes. And started a tyre business in the name of Hindustan Sales.

Joined the then Coromandel Camera Club and conducted 1st All India Exhibition at Visakhapatnam in 1983.

Two awards and a certificate of merit in the very 1st exhibition put me in a path of no return.

So far around 840 of my pictures have been exhibited in different National and International salons all over the world and have won more than 100 awards and certificates.

Conferred with Fellowship of India International Photographic Council (FIIPC) in the year 1999 in Fashion and advertisement section. Fellowship in photography is conferred upon a person in recognition to the person's mastery over the medium of photography and should already have the honours of Associateship of any International body for at least 3 years. Besides the candidate should have been active in the field of photography for past 15 years. He should have an excellent and regular service record for photography. The recipient must have at least 150 acceptances in IIPC/PSA approved National and International salons. A desirable qualification for this honour is specialization in any branch of photography with a high degree of originality.

There were several unique features in the Fellowship Honour to me:

- I have received Licentiateship in Black & white, Associateship in colour slides and Fellowship in colour prints medium. This shows the mastery over all three media of Photography and is first of its kind.
- First person in the country to receive Fellowship in Fashion and advertising photography,
- First person in Andhra and second in India to receive fellowship of IIPC,
 - The youngest recipient of this honour in India.

Life Time Achievement Award from Academy of Visual Media, New Delhi, received in January 2007.

I have revived the defunct Visakha Camera Club in 1990 and have already conducted two National and three International exhibitions in the city.

Already conducted six state level and national photography workshops at Araku, Bhimilipatnam, Delhi, Jabalpur, Bangalore, Jamshedpur, Mumbai, Andaman, Thailand and other places beside regular workshops at Visakhapatnam for beginners and professionals.

A regular faculty in National and International Workshops and conventions of Photography.

A regular faculty for studio lighting for Company likes Kodak Limited.

Executive committee member of A.P. State Akademi of Photography.

Many one man shows in Visakhapatnam and other places,

M Venkateswara Rao (Babulu) Hony. FICS, EFIAP, FFIP

MusiniVenkateswaraRao, who is popularly known to as 'Babulu',is a renowned photographer widely known across the entire Godavari belt. After being hailed for his impeccable talent in visual aesthetics from all over the world, 60 years old Babulu is now heading the vintage 70-year-old photo studio in Rajahmundry that was set-up by his father, MusiniBabuRao. He was born to BabuRao and Seetharathnam in 1958 on February 19. Apathetic towards education, soon he realized that his mind and soul are into capturing pictures, given his father's passion-driven profession.

Early life

While studying class 6 at the Lutheran School in Jampeta, Babulu started hanging around at his father's photo studio every day after school. He used to feast on idly for 15 paise and Tea for 10 paise, which is given as pocket money to him after work. Despite knowing that Babulu would take over the studio later, Babulu's father, BabuRao ensured that his son is well-versed about every aspect of photography before he can start his career.

At first Babulu was allowed in washing and grading the photos at the studio. Later, he slowly learned film developing at ChithajalluVenkatrao. Babulu's initial gurus were Jani,Raju, and Abdullah, who taught him about photo printing. He started printing passport copies and learnt clicking passport pictures. His first tryst with photography happened with a 120 camera, given to him by his father for practice. Meanwhile, Babulu was elected as the ASPL of the school but couldn't pass class 10th examinations.

First Assignment

Following this, Baburao had decided to send Babulu to learn

basics of the craft at a popular cine-photographer V S R Swamy. But destiny had it otherwise. Around the same time, a group of timber merchants have asked Babulu to accompany them on a 45 days north-India pilgrimage. Without a second thought, Babulu joined the group with his 120camera. He visited Kashmir, Delhi, Varanasi, Bodh Gaya, TriveniSangamam, Kolkata and came back with a couple of fantastic pictures.

While his father worked as a still-photographer for movies that were shot at Rajahmundry featuring VijayaNirmala, Anjali Devi, and Krishnaamong other cast, Babulu also tailed his father. After a few years, Bbaulu worked as a still-photographer for movies-'Sneham' by director Bapu, 'Ma VuriDevatha' directed by Giridhar. Gradually, the exuberant Babulu has achieved fame for his body of work and started carving a niche for himself out of scratch.

Accredited Photo Journalist

Babuluwas one of the earliest accredited photo journalists for the Information and Public Relations (I & PR) department. He exhibited great merit in photographing the floods and damaged Dowlesvaramanicut in the year 1986. For his timely captures during the natural disaster, Babulu received heaps of appreciation from public and government representatives alike.

He worked under press barons like Gandham Seetharamanjaneyulu, Pendyala, Varada Brahmanandam, Gandham Naga Subramanyam and seniors like V S S Krishna Kumar, R JagadeeswaraRao, SannidhanamSastry, Meesala Satyanarayana, G A Bushan Babu, Peddada Naveen, late Bellapu Srinivas. Also, Ganesh, Vadrevu Diwakar, Saradhi, Ramanarayana, Rajagopal, RaghavaRao were also a few of the third generation journalists Babulu has worked with. He also beautifully captured Godavari Pushkaralu from 1979 to 2015. Some of his note worthy works includesPasarlapudi ONGC Blow out in the year 1995.

Political connection

He worked with the likes of former Presidents Indira Gandhi, Rajiv Gandhi, Vajpayee, former CMs MarriChenna Reddy, N Janardhana Reddy, former Governors Krishnakanth, Kumud Ben Joshi, and currentChief MinisterChandrababu Naidu among others.Babulu moved closely with TDP party founder and former CM, NandamuriTarakaRamarao. He was there when the prolific actor initiated a political move and has been instrumental in covering his campaign before elections. After NTR became CM of the State, Babulu covered several public meetings that involved him.

It is no exaggeration if we say that Babulu has some very rare and vintage photographs of the political leaders, public representatives, and cinema artists in his archives. Till today, many budding photographers, photo journalists and enthusiasts knock his door to view his works and borrow some.

Awards

The first national award Babulu received was of a rose flower that he clicked at Tirupati. Smitten by the beauty of that image, professional photographer VellankiSriramamurthygot it printed and sent it to All India Photo Competition in the year 1980. The picture got selected and that is how Babulu's journey into renowned awards began. Ever since, Babulu joined pictorial Artists like auditor Sundara Ramaro, Akula Nageswara Rao, M.Ravindranath, U. Sreeramamurthy, Prabhakar, Madhu, V.V.Rama Sharma, K S R Murthy, Naalam Venakteswara Rao and others clicked several pictures of nature.

He exhibited his works for the first time in 1980 at a national level photography competition held at Kakinada. Then, he travelled with his pictures to Karimnagar, Koratla, Khammam, Rajahmundry, Hyderabad, Guntur, Atreyapuram, Vizianagaram. His works included genres- monochrome, prints and digs, color prints, color slides, photo journalism, travel photos and others. He exhibited a minimum of three thousand pictures and won 450 awards and merit certificates. Babulu's pictures won awards in Federation of Indian Photography (FIP), Indian International Photography Council (IIPC) competitions every year. He is the recipient of diamond grade of Indian International Photography Council in 2005 and received Excellence award and a degree by Federation International Art Photographic Organisationin 2012. Babulu also secured international distinction from an organization in USA.

Indian Junior Chamber Honored as Outstanding Young Person Award. He was given Andhrasri Award by Alluri Seetharamaraju Youth Organisation. He was also felicitated by Press Club of Rajahmundry and Atreyapuram VROs organization.

Photography Workshops

Babulu has organized several workshops for amateur and senior photographers across State. He worked as faculty for Hyderabad Photographic workshop and judged several national level photo competitions. He conducted photography workshops at Araku and Papikondalu. He traveled to every part of the State conducting workshops.

Babulu as Inspiration

A teacher named Sunees has designed the story of Babulu as a lesson for primary students, in a bid to encourage them to achieve big, irrespective of being highly educated. For this, Sunees has been given an award by National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT).

Personal Life

Babulu is married to M Amaravati and has two sons- Baburao and Vishnu Rathan. His two sons completed B. Tech by qualification but since they inherited the same genes Babulu has, they are now into photography. They also started getting recognition by organizations such as AICS already. Now he is president of Andhra Pradesh Photography Akademi.

"A P State Akademi of Photography -Historical Profile"

(Reprint from Lenslight, July 1997)

Art can be produced with any medium, a pencil, a brush, a pair of scissors and a camera too. There is a controversy all over the world whether photography is an art or a science or a technical skill of the craftsman or just a record of images. In India, this controversy has been ended by officially accepting it as art in February 1965, at the instance of Dr. N. Bhagwandas, IAS at the all India Cultural Ministers Conference held at Hyderabad, which was attended by Ministers for Cultural Affairs from the centre and states as well as the representatives of various cultural akademies and prominent persons in the field of arts. The conference has unanimously adopted a resolution as "this conference concedes the art in photography and appreciates the need for developing photography as an art. However, in view of the fact that the medium of photography is so much different from the other arts, this conference unanimously recommends the formation of separate Akademi both at the centre and the state to develop photography as an art."

A.P. Federation of Photographers

As a stop gap arrangement, an idea of forming a Federation of Photography as a regional body in A.P. was first mooted at
Guntur. Then, with the active initiative of Dr. N. Bhagwandas,
Founder President of Guntur Camera Club, The A.P. Federation
of Photographers as an apex body for the development of art in
photography was established in 1963 and enrolled different camera clubs of various districts of the state. In 3 years time, with the
conserted efforts of Dr. N. Bhagawandas, the A.P. Federation of
Photographers has attained the strength and stability of a full grown
and well established organisation and did yeomen service in the
development of photography, both in Andhra Pradesh and in India. It was mostly responsible for the establishment of a number
of camera clubs throughout the state and soon came up to be

recognised as one of the most active and efficient photographic organisations in India.

The Federation conducted regularly and successfully International Photographic Exhibition maintaining high standards of art in photography required in such exhibitions. With necessary guidence and financial assistance, The Federation started 28 clubs in the state which is a record for any state in India. Apart from continuous efforts of Dr. N. Bhagawands, other stalwarts in photography i.e. Sri Raja Triambak Raj Bhadur ARPS, PN Mehra EFIAP, ARPS, APSA, V Bapi Raju EFLAP, FAPSAP, Sri S.N. Achanta AFAPA, Sri L. Malakondajah AFAPA, M. Hassan AFIAP were guiding the Federation in pursuit of the development of art. The Federation helped to bring together photographers from all over India by organising All India Photographic Salons, State Conventions of Photography as also regional and all India Conventions, thereby contributing immensly for the promotion and improvement of art in photography. Regular and monthly photographic competitions, practical demonstrations, slide shows and talks on technical aspects of photography were conducted. In all the AP Federation of Photographers conducted 7 Regional conventions at various centres of A.P. which were well attended and highly appriciated. The Federation successfully conducted 5 international salons. 'Lenslight' first started in 1964 by the Federation as a modest 4 page newsletter and edited by Dr. N. Bhagwandas soon developed into a full fledged photographic magazine. It was entered, for the first time in the year 1966 in the Camera Club MagaZine contest organised by the Photographic Society of America, conpeted by Camera Clubs, Associations and Federations all over the worls and created history by winning 2nd prize and Green Ribbon of Honourable mention. Thereafter, every year it not only won the top awards but also Ribbons of Honorable mention for production values. In all, Lenslight has won Awards for 9 years, putting Andhra Pradesh and India in the photographic map of the world.

Formation of AP State Akademi of Photography

At last, the ceaseless efforts of Dr. N. Bhagwandas for the formation of a Govt. sponsored yet autonomous body for development of the art in photography has borne fruit. Nearly after 8 years of passing a resolution at the Cultural Ministers conference at Hyderabad, unanimously accepting photography as art and recommending to set up seperate akademies both at the centre and the state to encourage photography as an art, the Govt, of A.P. taking the lead has constituted "AP. State Akademi of Photography" on 15th Nov. 1973 through GO.No. 239. The preamble of the Govt. order reads:

"Government had under their consideration a proposal to set up a separate Akademi for Photography for semetime past. The All India Cultural Conference, at its meeting held in Hyderabad in 1965 has recommended formation of a separate Akademi for development of photography as an art. Andhra Pradesh enjoys the distinction of having the largest camera clubs in the country. The state has been the venue of a number of All India, International Photographic Exhibitions. The work done by the camera clubs of the state has acquired an eminent place in the field of All India Photography. Government have considered the various representations made in this behalf and feel that there is justification for haveing a seperate Akademi for photography in the State, so that there is co-ordination to develop the art of photography in an organised manner".

Thus the Govt. of A.P. has become a pioneer in the development of Art and Science of photography, being the first state to form a State Akademi of Photography. Till today A.P. is the only state, which has a successfully functioning Akademi in the country.

The Govt. has formed the Akademi with the following members initially:

The main objectives of the Akademi:

To encourage and promote general advancement of Art and Science of photography in all its forms, organising of photographic exhibitions, seminars, slide shows, improve facilities for study of photography as an art and science, to encourage and assist formation of camera clubs and photographic associations, to provide scope for training in practical photography to foster National and International contacts through exchange of photographic portfolios and to consititute awards to deserving photographers.

Dissolution of A.P. Federation of Photographers

On the formation of the A.P. State Akademi of Photography, the AP Federation of Photography, the AP Federation of Photographers with almost the same objects was wound up and its assests worth over Rs. 1 lakh transferred to the Akademi.

Lenslight

The Akademi has taken over the activities of the Federation including the publication of photographic journal Lenslight. The first issue of the Lenslight under the masthead of the AP State Akademi of Photography saw the light of the day on April 1975. The inaugural issue of Lenslight under the agies of the Akademi has won the coveted 1st place in the PSA bulletin contest, subsequently it also won the 1st place in 1978, 3rd place and plaque in 1983, thus setting a worls record by winning altogether 9 awards. Due to various reasons and pressure on Govt. Text Book Press. Hyderabad, and shifting of Dr. N. Bhagwands, after his retirement from Govt. service, the publication of Lenslight could not be continued from 1984 onwards.

With publication of this bulletin, the Akademi is again promissing to continue the publication of Lenslight in bulletin form. Apart from acting as an effective link between affliated clubs, its members and the Akademi, it works for the promotion of art.

National Conventions:

The Akademi has successfully organised and hosted the Silver Jubilee Convention of Federation of Indian Photography in 1977 and was universally accepted as the best organised convention. It attracted over 400 delegates from all over India. Earlier two such All India Convention hosted by Photo Circle - Hyderabad under the patronage of the Akademi in 1990 in Hyderabad, excelled in every aspect. It was attended by over 500 delegates from all over the country. The FIP has declared Sri B. Rajan Babu, the Convention Chairma, and K. Vishwender Reddy, Convention Secretary, as men of the convention for excellent arrangements and its grand success.

International Convention :

The Akademi successfully hosted the 6th International Convention of the Federation of Asian Photographic Art in Hyderabad in 1977. This is the 1st International Convention of Photography (FAPA) held in India. Delegated who attended the convention were from countries in S.E. Asia including the President and office bearers of FAPA from Taiwan and a large number of delegates from all over India. This convention paved the way for a better understanding on the view points of the trends in pictorial photography. Thanks to the efforts of the Akademi for obtaining clearance, this was the first time after over two decades that individuals from Taiwan were permitted to visit India. To mark the occasion a special first day cover was issued and postal authorities arranged special cancellation to highlight the convention.

Publications:

One of the impediments to the development of Art and Science in photography in India is the high cost and non-availability of good books on photography. In addition to making available "Lenslight" the photographic journal, the Akademi has also taken up publication of books on photography both in English and Telugu. So far Akademi has published 9 books on photography by eminent photographers. The Akademi has a programme for taking up such publications every year. Presently planning to bring out a book containing invaluable photographs of late Sri Raja Triambak Raj Bahadur ARPS and his famous doping method. The Akademi also encourages the publication of magazines on photography by making token grants.

Salons:

In addition to grants made to affiliated camera clubs for organising All India and International Salons, the Akademi has also been donating Academi silver and bronze medals to be presented to the winners. The Akademi has itself organised a number of All India Salons as also three International Salons most successfully.

Camera Clubs :

The Art in photography can best be encouraged in those interested in photography through mutual efforts. The Akademi ever since its inception and the Federation before that, has taken pains to ensure the formation of new camera clubs in the state as also advice, guide and help the existing clubs. A.P. today has perhaps the largest number of Camera Clubs as compared to any other state. The Akademi has been very liberal in recognising Camera Clubs. Clubs are recognised if they are registered and fall in line with the aims and objects of the Akademi. Model Byelaws are also available to them for adoption if they so desire. Every recognised club has a representative in the Akademi Council. No entrance fee or subscription is charged. In addition, the Akademi has also been making financial scanction to every recognised club in the state for taking up various photographic activities, such as organising workshops, conventions, salons etc. We are happy to record that these grants have gone a long way in helping the clubs in stepping up their activities. There has been marked increase in their photographic activities and the number of All India Salons organised in the state and workshops etc. have appreciably increased. Apart from these the members of the clubs are active participants in the National and International Salons winning laurels for themsleves and to their clubs. Due to the financial grants from the Akademi, members from our clubs participate in large numbers from our clubs participate in large numbers in National and Regional Conventions, thus enlarging scope to acquaint themselves with latest trends in photography. The Akademi with a view to develop further, seeks suggestions from camera clubs from time to time to frame suitable programmes. The Akademi is planning to introduce quarterly competition among the members of clubs from the next quarter onwards.

Regional Conventions:

As part of the revitalisation of camera clubs the Akademi is encouraging camera clubs to organise Regional conventions at various places in A.P. by making suitable financial grants. The idea is to encourage members to interest with others from all over the state and exchange ideas and learn the new trends in photography through various programes planned in such conventions. We are proud that the Regional convention organised in the Papi Hills of Godavari River by Photographic Association of Andhra, Rajahmundry was highly successful. In this process the present Regional Convention being organised by Photogenic Arts Circle has taken up the theme of the convention as "Modern Trends in Photography", rightly in tune with the first changing scenario in the field of photography. We are sure the convention will fulfil its objectives. The Akademi wishes that clubs will come forward to take up the task of organising Regional conventions every year.

Workshop:

We are very proud, that clubs in Andhra Pradesh made it a regular feature in organising workshop for the benefit of not only their members but also photographers from all over the state and some times from other parts of the country. The main guiding force behind this workshop movement in the state is B. RajanBabu, an eminent pictorial photographer and an excellent teacher. Over a decade, as secretary of the Akademi, hi is not only running it successfully but encouraged and inspired many people to start camera clubs in various parts of the state. He spared his valuable time by travelling through the length and breadth of state in conducting workshops, giving demonstrations on various subjects of photography. The clubs in A.P. reached a place on the map of photographic world of India, by making their workshops meaningful and highly informative, due to the consented efforts of everything Rajan Babu. He also trained and guided many photographers to achieve National & International honour a part from Sri B. Rajan Babu as Secretary, the Akademi is presently beaded by sri C.S. Sastri IAS; Retd., an able administrator and an excellent origanisor with his experience and wide knowledge, he is steering the Akademi efficiently to take-up more and more new projects, for the development of the art in our state. Sri K. NageshwaraRao with his experience in various fields of arts and photography is guiding the Akademi successfully. K. Vishwander Reddy, who is an excellent organizer and serious Photographer as treasurer, C.N. Babu. Who brings in rich experience and who is associated with the Akademi since its inception and the Federation earlier V. Sreeram Murthy, K. Prabhakar and K. Sudhakar Reddy, a strong team of the council is sparing no efforts in making the Akademi more vibrant and strong. Though Dr. N. Bhagwandas, founder, president has shifted his home to Madras, the Akademi is always receiving his guidance and advice in running it effectively.

150 Years of Photography:

The Akademi has organised a grand function on the occasion of 150th year of birth of photography. On the occasion, Photo Circle - Hyderabad under agies of the Akademi felicitated Dr. G. Thomas, Secretary General of the FIP and Dr. N. Bhagwandas the past president of FIP, and the founder president of the Akademi. The Akademi in colloboration with INTACH collected and preserved 150 rare pictures of great photographers for posterity for future generations.

The main remaining task of the Akademi, is to acquire a piece of land or a place to construct an exhibition hall, a dark room and a library. Also the Govt of A.P. has to release the Annual grant of Rs. 50,000l- p.a. due to the Akademi from several years. The Akademi has been making representations, on various occasions when dignitaries are attending functions of the Akademi and also personally meeting them with this request. It is time to pursue the Govt. vigorously and secure the release of Govt. grants and a piece of land to heme the Akademi.

Lack of good books in photography in India is one of the main impediments to the development of Art and Science in photography in our country. Our Akademi took a policy decision to take up good works on photography and publish them and make them available to the public at a reasonable price. The Andhra Pradesh Federation of photographers, the organisation which proceeded the Akademi had published a volume of Contemporary Photography. The AP State Akademi of Photography, in addition to making available Lenslight the photographic journal, published following books in English & Telugu and stood as the pioneer. It is the only organisation in the country to have so many photographic publications to its credit.

- 1. 1st Publication: The Akademi brought out its first publication in Telugu by V. Bapi Raju EFIAP. Popularly known as Father of Andhra Photography. The book was released by Sri J. Vengal Rao, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh in June 1976 in Hyderabad.
- 2nd Publication: "Book of Photography" by P.N. Mehra Hon. EFLAP, FRPS was released on 12th Sept. 1976 by Sri Fakrudding Ali Ahmed Honb'e President of India at dunction in Hyd.
- 3rd Publication: "Law on Photography and copy Right on Photographs" by Sri A. Arunachalam an eminent lawyer & photographer, was released by Sri A. Sambasiva Rao, Chef Justice of A.P. on 30-11-1978 at a function in Hyderabad.
- 4th Publication: "CHAYAGRAHIKA MARGADARSI" in Telugy by Sri B. Lakshman, dedicated photographer was released by Sri KC Abraham, Hon'ble Gvernor of A.P. on 27th December 1979 at a function in Hyderabad.
- 5. 5th Publication: "History of photography India 1840-1980" by Dr. G. Thomas, Founder Secretary of Federation of India

- Photography and an eminent photographer was released by Dr. N. Bhagwandas on 29th December 1981 at the FIP Convention at Bhopal.
- 6th Publication: "A Monograph" containing 24 pictures of A.L. Syed was released by Dr. N. Bhagwandas on 31st December 1981 at the concluding function of the FIP at Bhopal.
- 7th Publication: "Landscapes" by Dr. G. Thomas was released by Hon. Justice Sri P.N. Bhagwati, Judge Supreme Court of India at the 9th FIP Convention at Ahmedabad. This publication has won a second prize in the All India competition organised by the Govt. of India.
- 8th Publication: "Anatomy of Photography" by Dr. G. Thomas, was released by K. Krishnan Kant, Hon'ble Governor of A.P. at a function at Rajbhavan, Hyderabad on 14th November 1991.
- 9. 9th Publication: "AP Heritage of Photography" a collection of photographs of eminent photographers of yesteryears to the present generation photographers of A.P. was released by Sri K. Ashok Gajapathi Raju, Hon'ble finance Minister of A.P. at a function on 5-4-1997 at Hyderabad.

Presently the Akabemi is in the process of bringing out a book on the works of Late Sri Raja Triambak Raj Bahadur ARPS an eminent pictorialist of the country.

Under rule 12 of the constitution of the AP State Akademi of photography, the General Council may elect by a majority of not less than 3/4th of the members present and voting in a meetiong of the General Council, persons of outstanding merit in the field of photography not exceeding ten at anytime, as follows of the Akademi from among those recommended for election by Executive Committee. Accordingly the following eminent photographers of Anshra Pradesh, who and science in photography and also excelled in the field of photography have been elected as follows of Andhra Pradesh State Akademi of Photography since its inception in 1973.

- Dr. N. Bhagwandas was awarded the Akademi's 1st fellowship and was presented with the same by Sri Fakruddin Ali Ahmed Hon'ble President of India at a Public function on 6th Sept. 1975.
- Sri V. Bapiraju EFIAP is the 2nd reciepient of the Akademi's fellowship for the year 1976. But unfortunately, hardly two hours after the executive council has unanimously resolved to recommend the award of fellowship of the Akademi he has passed away on 4th Sept. 1976 at about 7.30 p.m.
- Sri B. RajanBabu, FRPS, AFIAP, FAPSAP is the 3rd receiepient of the Akademi's Fellowship. He was presented with the award at a function by Sri K. Krishan Kant Hon'ble Governor of A.P. on 14th November 91.


